



Planning and Preparing for an Active Shooter

The Delaware County Partnership for Public Safety will hold a special public safety program on **Thursday, May 19 from 9 a.m. to 12 noon** entitled "*Strategies to Protect You and Your Work Place from an Active Shooter.*" Interested individuals are invited to attend and register on behalf of Delaware County Council, District Attorney Jack Whelan, Neumann University's Center for Leadership, and the Delaware County Chamber of Commerce.

The program will provide public safety leaders, business owners and executives, and the general public with current information on the potential threat of an Active Shooter in the workplace and other public venues. Speakers will define the problem, discuss preparation and prevention, situational awareness, and response.

Leaders in the public safety field agencies that are tasked with preventing, preparing for, and responding to incidents involving an active shooter will share how they mitigate risk and the importance of maintaining situational awareness during events. Participants will also learn about the resources available from local, county, state and federal public safety partners to help with event planning and to lead more confidently

Registration is free and open to the public, however space is limited to the first 300 registrants. There is no charge to attend the event and a light breakfast will be provided during check-in from 8 a.m. to 9 a.m.
